How can we fortify ourselves in these times of stress? How can we re-connect with values that sustain a group/culture/society? What can each of us do to help stabilize our society? What wisdom do the Indigenous traditions offer?

This workshop will include talks by Tlakaheel, some experiential work as group sharing and discussions, learning ways to apply these ideas and wisdom to our daily life. There will be lots of time for you to bring questions for Tlakaheel to talk about. Remember that this is your workshop and Tlakaheel prefers to talk about what you are interested in. Tlakaheel has an amazing knowledge about many aspects of life here on earth, and can go into depth on almost any subject, so please let us know what you would like to hear about. If you can write us ahead, even better. We will go thru mid day on Monday so try to come to the whole workshop, but it is possible to come for just part of the weekend if you can't stay the whole time. We will most likely share a Temazkal (sweat lodge) with Tlakaheel during the time, and there is of course no fee for that, as with all our ceremonies.
